THANK YOU FOR CHOOSING US FOR YOUR PURCHASE!

HYBRIDISNG DAHLIAS

OUR SEEDS ARE OPEN-POLLINATED, WHICH MEANS THAT WE LET NATURE, PREDOMINATELY BEES, BUT MANY OTHER INSECTS DO THE WORK OF TRANSFERRING POLLEN TO EACH DAHLIA FLOWER. DAHLIAS ARE CLASSIFIED AS OCTOPLOIDS, WHICH MEANS THEY CARRY EIGHT CHROMOSOMES, UNLIKE MANY LIVING THINGS WHICH ONLY HAVE TWO, INCLUDING US!

WE COLLECT THE SPENT FLOWER HEADS, SORT FOR SEED & TEST PERIODICALLY FOR VIABILITY (PRESENCE OF AN ENDOSPERM) ALL BY HAND - SOME CULTIVATORS PRODUCE LITTLE TO NO SEED, OTHERS ARE BOUNTIFUL.

A DAHLA SEED IS NEVER TRUE TO THE PARENT PLANT, BUT IT CARRIES THE DNA CHROMOSOMES OF BOTH TO CREATE A UNIQUE FLOWER, SOMETIMES THE NEXT MUST-HAVE BLOOM, OTHERS THE UGLY DUCKLING!

THIS IS PART OF THE FRUSTRATION & WONDER OF HYBRIDISING DAHLIAS!

GERMINATION

WE RECOMMEND STARTING OFF YOUR SEEDS INDOORS AROUND 6-8
WEEKS BEFORE THE LAST FROST, FOR US IN VICTORIA, THAT IS
USUALLY MELB CUP WEEKEND, SO WE AIM TO PLANT SEEDS IN
EARLY SEPTEMBER. THEY WILL START BLOOMING APPROXIMATELY
100-120 DAYS AFTER SPROUTING.

START YOUR SEEDS, BY PLACING THEM INSIDE A SHEET OF MOIST PAPER TOWEL, PLACING THEM INSIDE A RESEALABLE SANDWICH BAG WITH THE PARENT CULTIVAR WRITTEN ON THE FRONT. PLACE THE BAG IN A WARM AREA, AROUND 20C IS IDEAL, AND AFTER THREE DAYS, CHECK THEM DAILY. AS THEY GERMINATE, CAREFULLY TRANSFER THEM TO INDIVIDUAL SEED CELL GROWING TRAYS, FILLED WITH A GOOD QUALITY SEED-RAISING MIX & PLACE UNDER A GROW LIGHT OR ON A SUNNY WINDOWSILL.

ONCE THEY ARE GROWING THEIR TRUE LEAVES ITS TIME TO REPOT THEM INTO INDIVIDUAL POTS. WHEN TRANSPLANTING ADD SOME SLOW-RELEASE FEED TO YOUR MEDIUM. KEEP THEM MOIST AT ALL STAGES POST GERMINATION, NOT WET. YOU CAN FEED ONCE A WEEK WITH A 1/4 STRENGTH LIQUID FEED TOO.

ONCE ALL RISK OF FROST IS PAST THEY ARE READY TO PLANT IN YOUR GARDEN. TO HARDEN THEM OFF BEFORE PLANTING, PLACE THEM OUTSIDE IN FILTERED SUNLIGHT EACH DAY. STARTING FOR

ONLY ONE HOUR AND INCREASING DAILY OVER A WEEK.
IN AROUND 8-9 WEEKS THEY WILL ALREADY HAVE FORMED A
SMALL TUBER! YOU CAN ALSO SINK THE POT INTO THE GROUND
ENTIRELY, THIS MAKES LIFTING THE FIRST YEAR'S TUBERS MUCH
EASIER COME WINTER FOR STORING!
